



South American Explorer Mixed Half Dozen

INTRODUCTION

A mixed selection from Chile and Argentina, both producing wines that, while familiar, can be a bit more interesting if you seek out the more challenging areas away from the mass produced. A good example is the Sauvignon Blanc from Patagonia, a hot, flat plain that is tempered by wind that cools the vines, while a little further north you find Gouguenheim making Pinot Noir in the high 'lost valley' above Uco. Both of these Argentinian wines, and our own-label Argentinian

Malbec, are made with restraint and elegance rather than power and weight, bringing better balance to the end wine. Stir in the White Malbec and you have a range of interesting flavours. Over in Chile we've teamed up with Sutil Wines to make a wonderfully lush Chardonnay, full of moreish tropical fruit, while the flag-bearing Carmenère grape from Santa Ema, with its rich, spicy character, brings a further dimension to getting to know the wines of South America.

THE WINES

1. Ojos del Sur Sauvignon Blanc, Patagonia

Bin No:TW024

A rich Sauvignon Blanc with lovely weight and density, some tropical fruit flavour with a delicious savoury note adding complexity, before a fine elegant finish.

2. Gouguenheim Pinot Noir, Valle de Uco, Mendoza NEW!

Bin No:TR063

Intense aromas of raspberries and cherries, with mint notes. Medium-bodied wine, with soft, silky tannins and well-balanced acidity.

3. Tanners Argentinian Malbec, Mendoza

Bin No:TR052

Juicy, open nose, full and ripe palate with lovely black and red fruits and an appealing fresh character make this an ideal all-rounder.

4. Las Pampas White Malbec, Mendoza NEW!

Bin No:TW025

Soft and round with floral notes and attractive peachy fruit on the palate. Quite full but with enough freshness to give balance.

5. Tanners Chilean Chardonnay, Colchagua Valley

Bin No: QW098

An exuberant Chardonnay with flavours of paw-paw and mango, characterised by an excellent fruit-filled, juicy finish.

6. Santa Ema Gran Reserva Carmenère, Cachapoal

Bin No: QR073

A cracking, barrel-aged Carmenère packed with rich, ripe blackberry and blueberry fruits, laced with black pepper, spice, tobacco and chocolate. Offers excellent value for money.
