THE WINES

- 1. Gancedo Godello, Vino de Altura, Bierzo** Bin No: SW113
Plenty of ripe yellow and orchard fruit on the nose with lovely sweet apple and pear fruit on the palate with an elegant, mineral note on the long refreshing finish.
- 2. Riesling Trocken, Rings, Pfalz** Bin No: GW156
Lemon citrus powering through with plenty of green apple. Refreshing and crisp with trademark pinpoint acidity to cleanse. Fresh and fruity - typically Pfalz!
- 3. Domaine de la Cendrillon Minuit Rosé, Corbières** Bin No: FP054
An elegant but flavour-filled rosé with a beautiful colour. The nose is fresh and floral with notes of hibiscus and rose as well as citrus fruit. On the palate there are flavours of pink grapefruit and tangerines.
- 4. Bodega Piedra Negra Reserve Malbec, Mendoza** Bin No: TR013
Full of smoky, spicy, black fruits, damson and Morello cherries, with good structure, balanced tannins and the sort of refinement you expect from a top producer like François Lurton.
- 5. Altano Naturalmente, Organic Douro Tinto, Symington** Bin No: PR038
Big and concentrated with a delightful violet scented nose and plenty of fresh, brambly fruit, spice and ripe tannins. From the Vilarica Valley near the Spanish border.
- 6. Le Mas, Coteaux du Languedoc, Domaine Clavel** Bin No: FR083
Pierre Clavel produces this interesting, herby wine in Montpeyroux, one of the finer Languedoc sub-areas. Intense strawberry and bramble fruits with ripe juicy tannins; a marriage of wild garrigue herbs with Rhône-style flavours.
