## Luxury Dozen

Gouguenheim Blue Melosa (Malbec), Flores del Valle, Mendoza, Argentina x 2 A rich dark wine, with red and black fruits on the nose and palate, delicious creamy vanilla spice and a lovely lifted finish. Well balanced with good length.

## Redoma, Douro Branco, Niepoort, Portugal x 2

Made from 40 to 80-year-old vines, this vibrantly fresh and aromatic white displays notes of white flowers and nuts, with exciting complex ripe fruit flavours of lemon, orange and apricot.

Château du Courlat, Cuvée Jean Baptiste, Lussac-St-Emilion, France x 2 100% Merlot. Dark black fruit mixes with sweet cinammon spice on the nose. The palate has plenty of weight from the black fruit with an added strawberry compote freshness. There is clear structure here whilst the tannins are soft and fine.

Viña Magna Tempranillo, Ribera del Duero, Dominio Basconcillos, Spain x 2 Packed full of crunchy black fruit flavours, this characterful wine is a blend of Tempranillo with small amounts of Mazuelo and Cabernet. It is full bodied with ripe tannins and a long finish. (Organic & Vegetarian)

## Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine Thibault, Firmin Dezat, France x 2

The Dezats produce elegant, very fine white wines and this Pouilly-Fumé is no exception, notable for its fruit and the smoky gun-flint characteristics so indicative of this famous region.

Château Rives-Blanques Odyssée, Chardonnay, Limoux, France x 2

This domaine's showpiece wine is made using the best grapes, fermented and matured in French oak. Burgundian in style, it has featured on the dream wine list of three 'Best Sommelier in the World' winners. (Organic & Vegan)
